

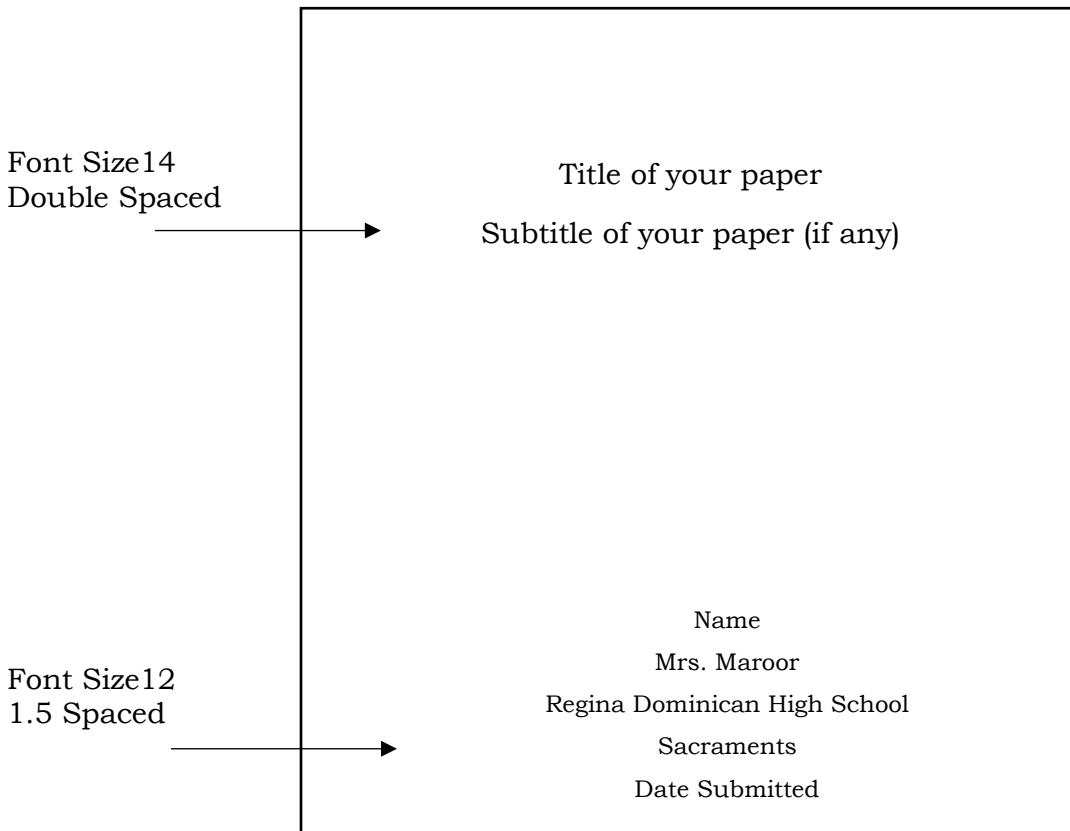
Detailed Instructions for

Renew the Church Research Project

In the following document, you will be provided with more in-depth, detailed instructions regarding the structure and format of you research project. Please talk to Mrs. Maroor with any questions.

- I. Annotated Bibliography (Due March 24, 2017 into Showbie)
 - a. Should include at least 4 sources.
 - b. 3-5 sentence annotation for each source that talks about:
 - i. The source itself- What is it? Where is it from?
 - ii. What information have you received/do you wish to receive from it?
 - iii. How do you plan to use it in your paper?
- II. Basic details of the Research Paper
 - a. 3-5 pages in length; double spaced; use font *Times New Roman* in size 12.
 - i. This does not include the Cover Page
 - ii. This does not include the Works Cited Page
 - b. General Format should be MLA Style regarding citation and page numbering with the following exception:
 - i. Paper should include a Cover Page. See below.
 - ii. Because you will include a Cover Page, the usual heading on the first page of the paper for MLA formatting is not needed.
- III. Cover Page: The Cover page should be formatted as below.



- IV. Body of the Paper
 - a. The paper itself cannot exceed 5 pages and must be no less than 3 pages. All the pages should have 1 inch margins all the way around.

- b. Your paper should clearly maintain an introduction, body, and conclusion.
- c. You do not need to separately title each section of your paper. It should be written as a continuous essay.
- d. The basic structure and purpose of the paper should be three fold. The specific questions for each sections are in the assignment sheet.
 - i. Address the time period/phase of Church History you have chosen.
 - ii. Address the life of the individual saint you have chosen from this period/phase.
 - iii. Address the question of how this individual's life comes to show the working of the Holy Spirit in the Church.
- e. These three sections do not need to be addressed in this order, however, all these topics should be covered in the body of your paper.

V. Works Cited Page

- a. The Works Cited should be formatted according to MLA formatting.
- b. You do not need annotations for your final Works Cited page.
- c. 1 inch margins and the same Font and Size requirements apply for the Works Cited page.

VI. Poster

a. General Requirements

- i. The size of the poster you choose to include is up to you. However, it must be a poster which means it must be:
 - 1. Larger than an 8x11³/₄ sheet of paper
 - 2. Must be poster quality
 - 3. All images and attached texts, etc. should be securely placed on the poster.
- ii. The poster will be the only piece of the project you will be physically handing into Mrs. Maroor on the day (or days previous) to when your paper is due.
- iii. You do not need to include a poster with your rough draft.

b. Format and Structure

- i. Just as your paper addresses three concerns, your poster should be a visual representation of these concerns. They should be visually summarized in your poster.
- ii. Should include:
 - 1. Title
 - 2. Clear labeling of the Individual's life and Time Period or Phase you have chosen
 - 3. At least one image relating to your Individual you chose.
 - 4. The rest is up to you! Get creative.

VII. Rough Draft (Due April 4, 2017 Turnitin.com) vs. Final Paper (Due April 12, 2017 on Turnitin.com)

- a. Rough Draft does NOT need to include:
 - i. Title Page
 - ii. Poster
 - iii. Annotated Bibliography
- b. Rough Draft does include:
 - i. Proper MLA formatting
 - ii. Works Cited Page
